Transitions Summer Program:

Transitions is a summer day camp program that offers children the opportunity to develop responsibility, independence, money management, life skills and social skills. Counsellors guide children as they plan and organize their own activities and adventures. Staff must be able to work with children ages 5 to 12, facilitate the Transitions philosophy by encouraging children to make decisions and develop independence, guide children in their activity planning, ensure safety, implement behavior guidance strategies, and undertake administrative and organizational duties. Staff must be able to work independently.
