Position: Full Time Term Supply Staff (Toddler/Preschool and Kindergarten/School Age) for our West End locations.

Job Summary:

Will be employed to cover staff absences or situations where additional staffing is required. Reporting to the Supervisor of the centre, the supply educator role is to provide care for the physical and emotional needs of the group and individual children while developing and encouraging positive and secure relationships. She/he will work as part of a team on managing the day to day activities of the rooms within the Children's Village program statement, policies and procedures, and all legislative and regulatory standards. Maintain confidentiality at all times. The Supply Educator needs to have reliable transportation and be extremely flexible with last minute shift changes, possible split shifts, and location of work.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent;

- > A minimum of one year experience in a Licensed Child Care Program with the appropriate age groups;
