Summary of Cook position:

The Child Care Centre Cook manages the kitchen in strict compliance with Ottawa Public Health Department, Child Care and Early Years Act and all other applicable regulations and legislation. They are responsible for menu planning and implementation, purchasing of groceries and supplies and daily preparation of allergy-aware nutritious menus and snacks served to the children. The Childcare Centre Cook works in consultation with the Program Supervisor to ensure the smooth operation of the kitchen and its coordination with the programs of the centre. They also work in the program with the children as required.

Qualification for the Cook position:

- > Diploma in Culinary Arts Program, an asset;
- Minimum of 2 years' experience as a cook, preferably in a childcare setting;
- ➤ Food Handlers Certificate;
- > Valid Ontario Driver's License and a vehicle or alternative method of transportation to get grocery purchases to the Childcare Centre;
- Familiarity with planning and implementing menus around the Canada Food Guide and within Ottawa Public Health Department guidelines;
- Creative and age appropriate ideas for meal planning;
- Ability to work in a face-paced environment:
